Program on plastic surgery dangers highlighted Weston tragedy

Weston, FL -- Weston attorney Michael Freedland recently appeared on the national daytime talk show Katie, hosted by award winning journalist Katie Couric to discuss the dangers of plastic and cosmetic surgery. Freedland, a partner with Freedland Harwin, PL with offices in Weston and Fort Lauderdale, is currently representing the surviving children of Maria Shortall, the Hollywood mother who died in 2011 after critical errors were made in what should have been a simple liposuction procedure. He also informed viewers about what they can do to protect themselves should they ever consider cosmetic enhancements in the future. Maria's children also appeared on the show which ran locally on WPLG-TV Local 10.
